In the Glasgow area our highly trained volunteer caseworkers support mainly veterans providing practical, friendly and non-judgemental support.

They desperately needed a gas cooker and tiles for the kitchen floor. The Royal Navy Benevolent Trust and Poppyscotland had no hesitation in assisting them.

A young man had recently left the Services and was struggling getting employment. He had hoped to get a job on the Oil Rigs but could not afford the training. Poppyscotland provided the funds for his training and his Regiment covered accommodation and travel costs. This young man now has a job with great prospects and hopes one day to repay us by volunteering some of his free time to SSAFA.

Our special project Glasgow's Helping Heroes, funded by Glasgow City Council, is a one stop shop to support Veterans and their families accessing existing services across a wide range of areas.
